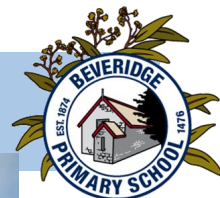

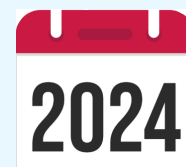
2024 enrolments are now open. Please contact the office at either campus for all enrolment enquires. Foundation enrolments will close on Friday 28th July.

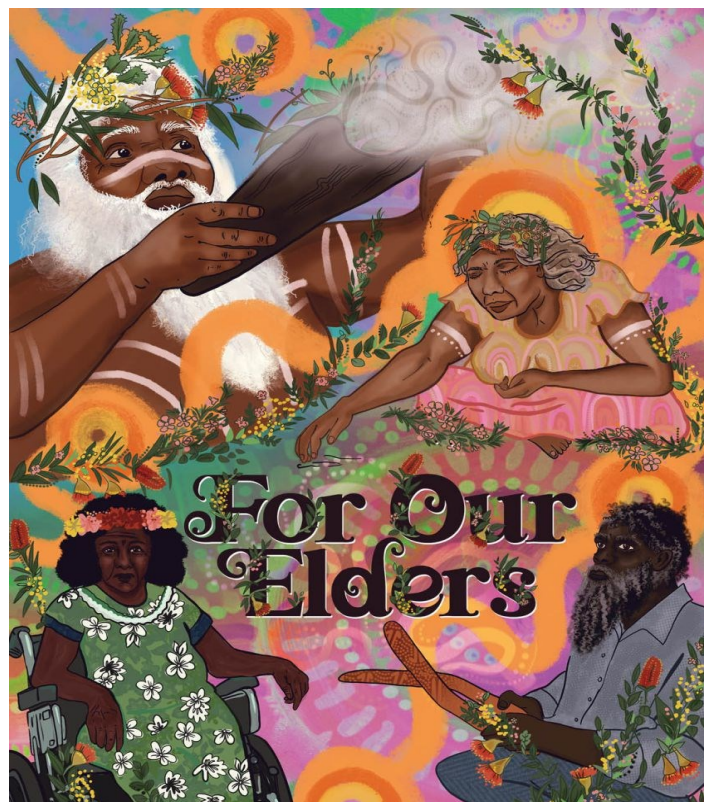
