Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

What is Badminton?

Badminton is a fun sport where players hit a shuttlecock over a net using racquets. You can play with one other person (singles) or in teams of two (doubles).

What equipment do you play with?

You will need a badminton racquet and a shuttlecock. These will be provided, but you can bring your own if you like.



Can children attend the come and try event?

Children over 5 are welcome to participate. Children must be supervised at all times, and are the responsibility of their parent, carer, or adult.

What do I do when I arrive?

When you arrive at the stadium, go to the front doors to enter the court area. A staff member will greet you, tell you where to go, and help you get ready to play. Staff will be wearing lanyards with their name.

What facilities will be at the basketball stadium?

The stadium has accessible toilets, seating, drinking water, and space for bags. There are ramps to enter the building.

Can I bring things to help me feel comfortable and confident to join in?

Yes! You can bring items like headphones, a comfort item, or anything else that helps you feel comfortable. Carers and Support Workers welcome.

I don't want to play. Can I come and watch?

Yes! Come along and cheer on from the stands.
