Where: Beveridge Community Centre, 72-76 Lithgow Street, Beveridge (also known as Beveridge Community Hall, that's located within Beveridge Recreation Reserve)

The new environmental volunteer group could have a focus on community environmental education and enhancing the environmental values of public land areas in Beveridge. For example, it could organise environmental activities such as community tree planting days, nature/bird watching walks, frog nights, spotlighting for native wildlife, litter clean-ups etc. The group could also engage Beveridge residents in environmental programs such as Gardens for Wildlife. Note - the name and the focus of the new environmental volunteer group will be decided by the residents of Beveridge who want to be involved in the group, and who will drive its focus, priorities, and activities.

The local area has a Landcare facilitator who can support the environmental volunteer group with its activities such as helping plan and secure project funding.

How do I get involved?

Come along to the community meeting to meet other like-minded locals, discuss what environmental issues are important to you, what a new environmental volunteer group in Beveridge could do, and also hear from guest speakers from local environmental volunteer and Landcare groups about their work, and what's involved.
