

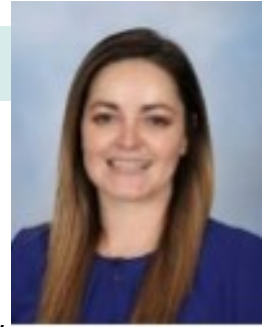

### WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

#### PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

If your child is absent from school or is picked up early, you must inform us. Please call us or send us an email. If we are unaware of where your child is, it is a legal requirement that we follow up with a phone call, if we cannot contact you or your emergency contacts emergency services will be contacted. Also, when dropping off your child in the morning, you MUST walk your child to the service. We cannot sign a child in/out without the presence of an ADULT and not siblings under 18.

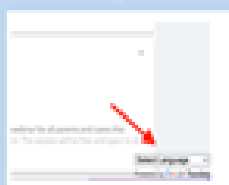
