

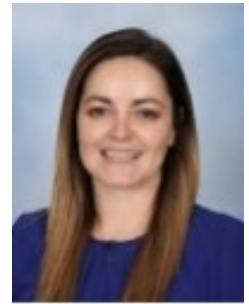

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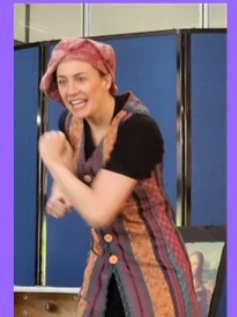

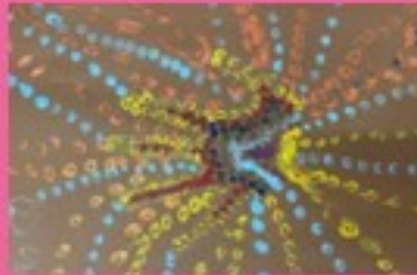

WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

If your child is absent from school or is picked up early, you must inform TeamKids. Please call, text, or send us an email. If we are unaware of where your child is, it is a legal requirement that we follow up with a phone call, if we cannot contact you or your emergency contacts emergency services will be contacted. Also, when dropping off your child in the morning, you MUST walk your child to the service. We cannot sign a child in/out without the presence of an ADULT and not siblings under 18.

LATE PICKUPS:

Parents and Guardians, please call us to let us know that you will be late picking up your child in the evenings as we have had a number of children being picked up late and no answer when contacted. Just a reminder both campuses close at 6 p.m. A fee of \$15 will be added for every 15 min block, meaning if you are just 5 min late it is still a \$15 fee.

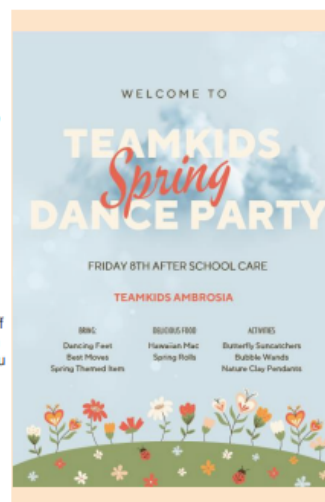
SPRING DANCE PARTY:

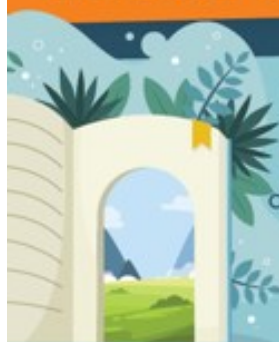
